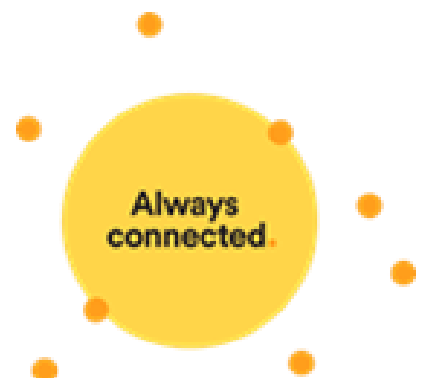


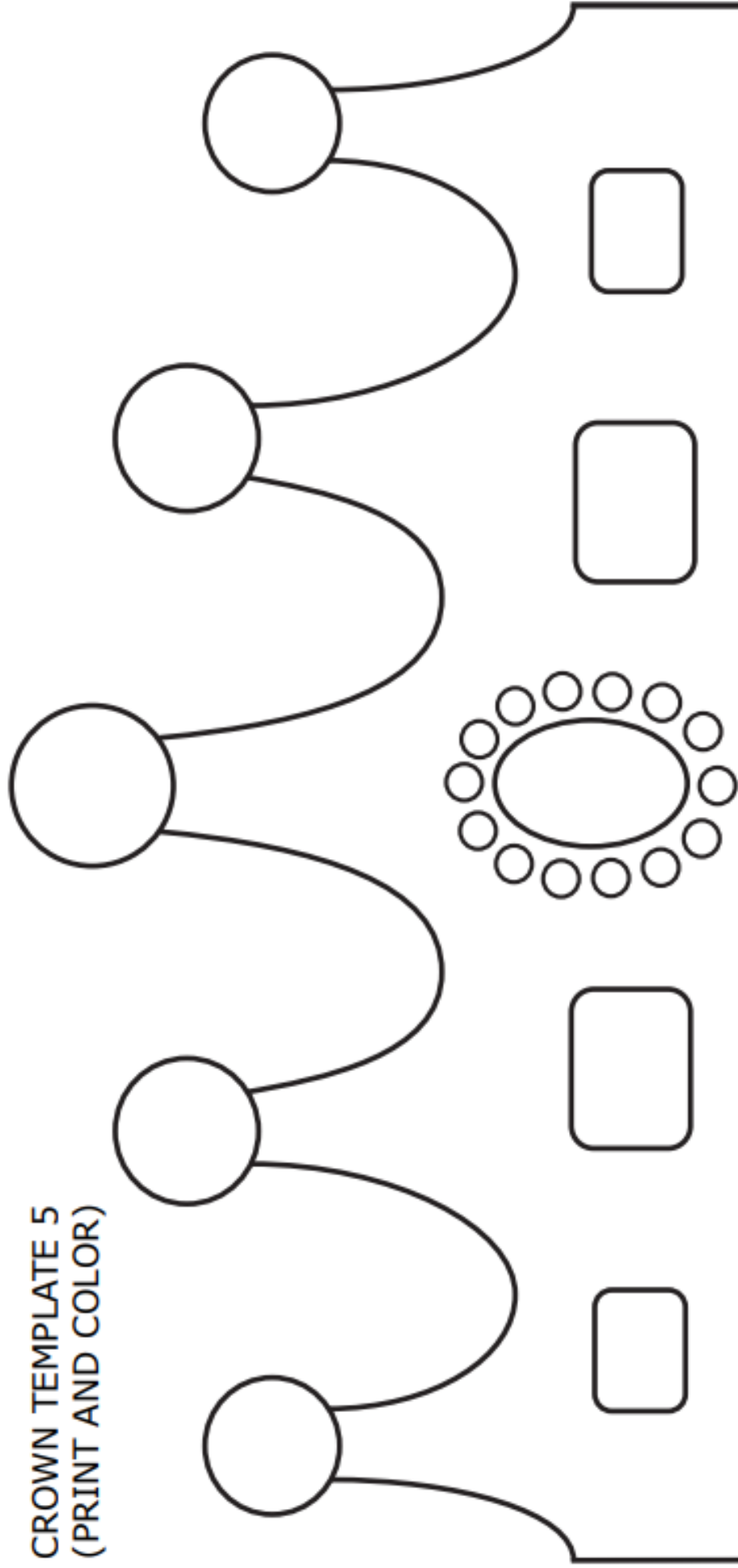

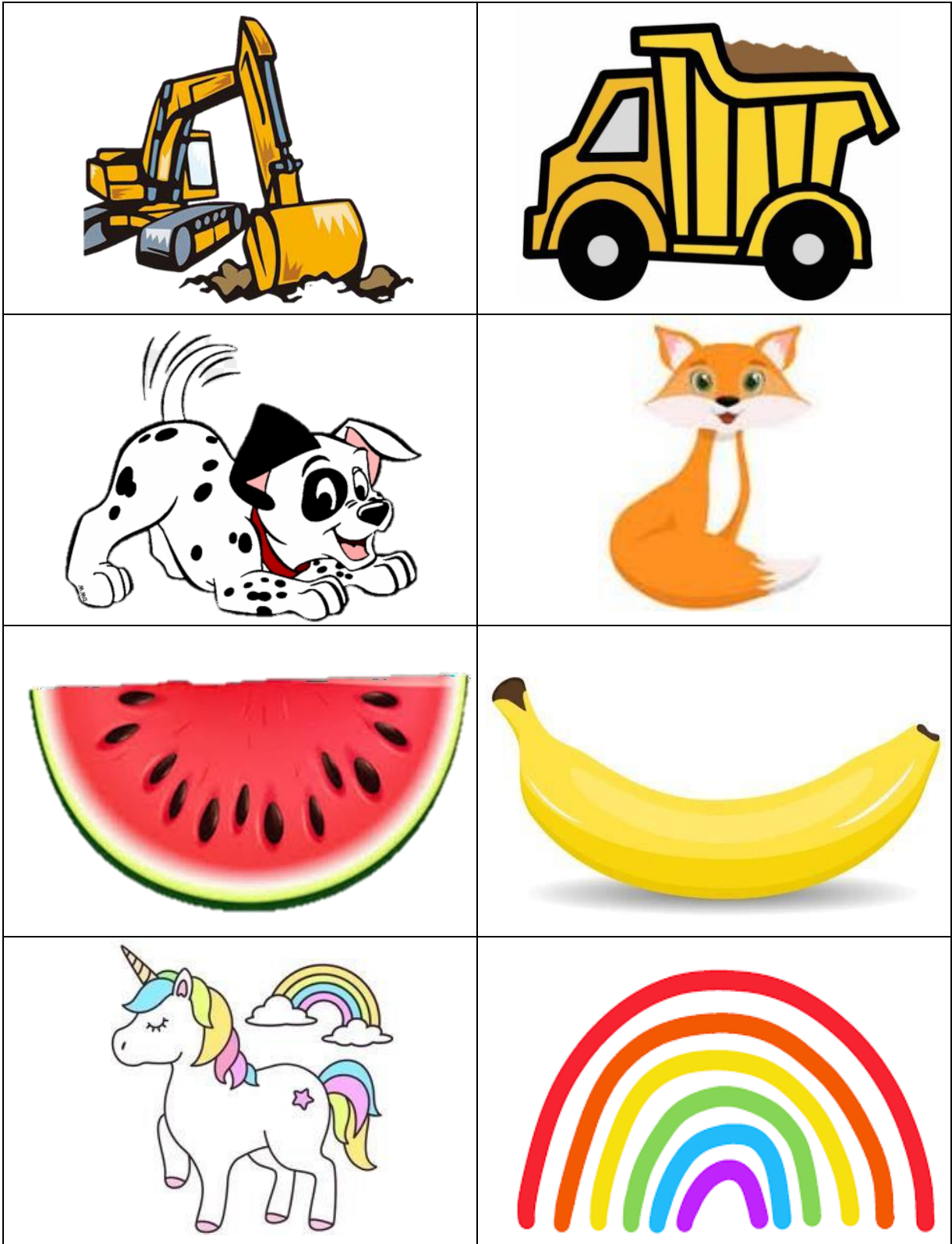


CROWN TEMPLATE 5

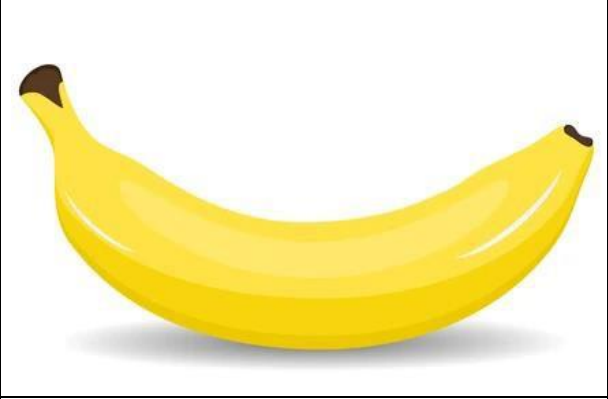
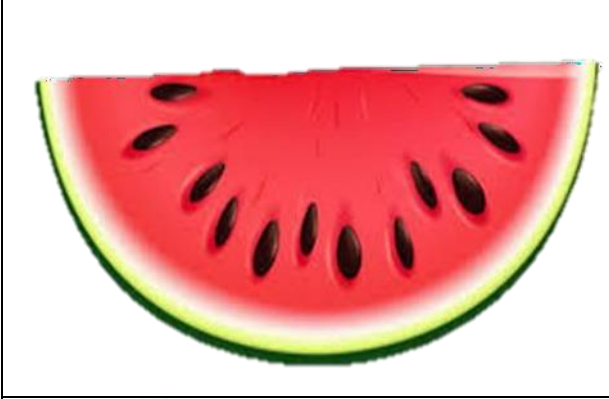


## MATCHING CARD GAME:

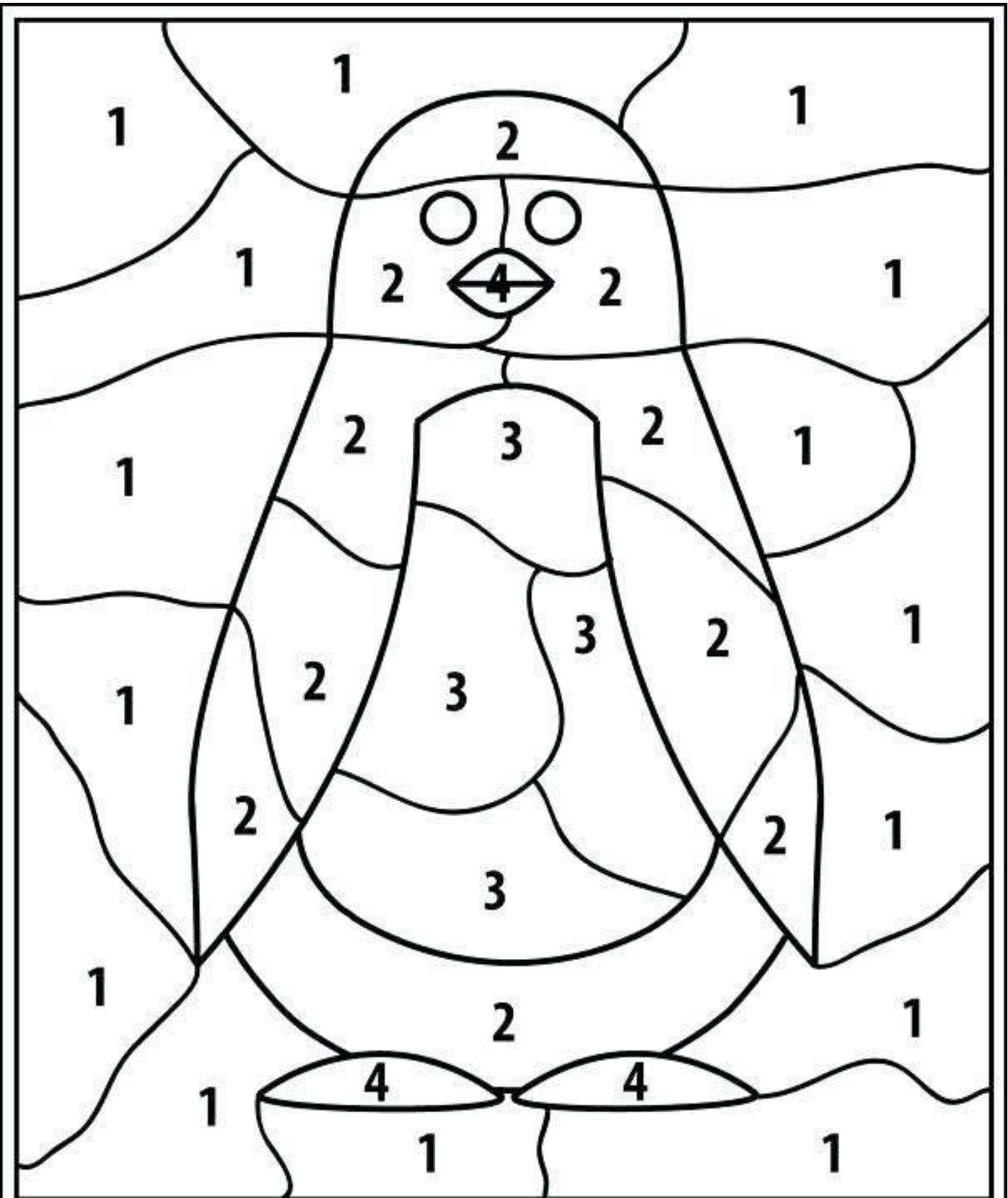
1. Cut out the second copy of the cards. (Second page).

# Galaxy Gardens Cosmic Maze

## Playdough Recipes

### Cooked playdough:

#### INGREDIENTS:

- 2 cups plain flour
- 1 cup salt
- 4 tablespoons cream of tartar
- 2 cups cold water (few drops of **food colouring** added to water)
- 2 tablespoons oil (baby oil or cooking oil)

#### METHOD:

1. Mix the flour, salt, and cream of tartar together.
2. Place mixed ingredients into a saucepan.
3. Add the water and oil.
4. Stir continuously over medium heat for 3-5 minutes or until the consistency becomes pliable and not sticky.
5. Let cool slightly, remove from saucepan, and knead dough until smooth. If sticky add more flour.
6. Store playdough in a well-sealed container or plastic bag.



## Microwave Playdough:

### INGREDIENTS:

- 2 cups plain flour
- 1 cup salt
- 4 tablespoons cream of tartar
- 2 cups cold water (few drops of **food colouring** added to water)
- 2 tablespoons oil (baby oil or cooking oil)

### METHOD:

1. Mix the flour, salt, and cream of tartar together.
2. Place mixed ingredients into a microwave-safe bowl.
3. Add the water and oil.
4. Microwave for 2 minutes.
5. Carefully remove from microwave and stir well.
6. Microwave for another 1 minute 30 seconds.
7. Carefully remove and stir well.
8. Microwave for an additional 30 seconds.
9. Ensure the mixture is forming together and not sticky.
10. Let cool slightly and knead dough until smooth.
11. Store in a well-sealed container or plastic bag.



## Uncooked Playdough

### INGREDIENTS:

- 2 cups flour
- 1/2 cup salt
- 2 tablespoons cream of tartar
- 1 to 1.5 cups boiling water (make sure to add half a cup at a time until the consistency forms a dough.
- 2 tablespoons oil (baby oil or cooking oil)
- Food colouring

### METHOD:

1. Mix the flour, salt, cream of tartar and oil together in a large bowl.
2. Add the food colouring to the boiling water.
3. Add the coloured water, half cup at a time, to the dry ingredients in the mixing bowl.
4. Stir continuously until the dough becomes only slightly sticky.
5. Take the dough out of the bowl and knead until the dough becomes smooth and elastic.
6. Add flour if the dough is too sticky.
7. Store in a well-sealed container or plastic bag.



## Cloud Playdough

### INGREDIENTS

- 2 cups corn-starch
- 1 cup conditioner
- Food colouring (optional)

### METHOD

1. Pour conditioner into a mixing bowl.
2. Add the corn-starch.
3. Mix until it combines.
4. Add food colouring (optional).
5. Use your hand to ensure the mixture is combined.





## Edible Playdough

### INGREDIENTS:

- 6 large marshmallows
- 2 teaspoons coconut oil
- 4 tablespoons corn-starch
- Food colouring (optional)

### METHOD

1. Warm marshmallows and coconut oil in microwave for 30 seconds.
2. Carefully remove and stir in food colouring.
3. Stir in corn-starch.
4. Let cool slightly and knead dough until smooth.
5. Add corn-starch if the dough is too sticky.
